Pageant Rules:

1. Contestants participating in the Junior Miss Winnebago County Fair Queen Pageant must be no younger than 8 and no older than 12 years of age as of Tuesday, August 16, 2011.
2. Candidates must be single and have never been married or pregnant.
3. Candidates must be a Winnebago County resident or are currently attending a Winnebago County school. Contestants from another county may also compete if their county does not have a pageant for the given any division.
4. Candidates will be judged as follows: Formal & Face, Fun Fashion Wear, Personal Interview, Speech & Stage Presence.
5. Candidates will be required to appear in a floor length or tea length formal, and a fun fashion wear outfit onstage, as well as an interview suit or Sunday dress for personal interview.
6. No preliminary contest will be held unless deemed necessary by the Pageant Committee of this contest. In case of a preliminary contest, all contestants will be notified.
7. In case of a marriage, pregnancy, or if for any reason the Queen is unable to fulfill her obligations as the reigning Queen, she agrees to relinquish her title and all privileges and prizes awarded to her. The Executive Committee of the WCFA and the Director(s) of the pageant have the discretion of recall, and the Queen will be succeeded by the next eligible runner-up.
8. Contestants agree that the decisions of the judges are final.
9. Hair & makeup for the pageant should be age appropriate.
10. All clothing must be viewed and approved by the Pageant Director(s).
11. The newly selected Junior Miss will serve along with the Little Miss & Queen at the Winnebago County Fair.
12. The Newly crowned Junior Miss Queen will use extreme caution and is encouraged to make certain there are no unnecessary photos on their Facebook or MySpace pages. This includes written comments.
13. The newly crowned Junior Miss Queen will abstain from public displays of affection towards their boyfriend during fair week and all appearances.
14. The winner of the contest agrees to participate in functions becoming of a Queen which may arise during the year, including parades and other appearances approved by the Pageant Director. Activities connected with the Winnebago County Fair should take precedence over and above all other personal appearances.
15. Candidates must have parents'/legal guardians' written consent.
16. Scholarship will be awarded upon completion of Queen's reign.
