### **\*\*SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS REQUIRED ON ALL ENTRIES\*\***

1. All general, special junior livestock and open beef rules apply.
2. Entry fees are \$2.50 per entry, stall rent is \$5.00 per stall. (Each exhibitor must pay entry and stall fees regardless of 4-H participation.)
3. Animals will not be released until 5:00 P.M. August 19, 2018. Premium checks will be passed out at 4:00 P.M. that same day. First place monies will be paid in all classes that have entries.
4. No Bulls in the Junior Beef Show. All beef females must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor only. NO EXCEPTIONS! Every breeding female (over 6 months of age) must be registered with a breed association. This includes females shown in Section 6, Other Breeds.
5. There must be four different family breeders in any breed or they will be combined and judged with other breeds.
6. All market animals must weigh in Tuesday evening between 7:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. NO REWEIGHS.
7. The Winnebago County Fair Junior Beef Show is an IBA Points Show.
8. Registration papers will be checked.
