SPECIAL RULES

****SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS REQUIRED ON ALL ENTRIES****

- 1. All junior exhibitors are expected to abide by the Winnebago County Fair Association's General Rules and Regulations, as stated in the front portion of the premium book, and with the rules for the individual open classes.
- 2. Anyone between the ages of eight (8) or in third grade and not yet Twenty-one (21) years of age on or before September 1, 2024 is eligible to participate in junior classes.
- 3. Any junior exhibitor may also compete in the open classes of the fair by complying with the rules governing those respective classes.
- 4. No first bedding will be furnished.
- 5. Evidence of ownership by exhibitor, satisfactory to the judge, must be available at time of entry. Animals must be registered in the name of the child showing the animal. Animals registered in the name of a parent and child, or in the name of a farm will not be accepted in junior competition. ANIMALS MUST BE REGISTERED IN CHILD'S NAME ONLY.
- 6. All Animals must be on the grounds by 8:00 A.M, August 13, 2025
